**Minutes from July 7th meeting
At LeNoir Bistro, Lenoir City, TN**

President Ty called the meeting to order – 17 in attendance

Don Zerrip gave the Treasurer's Report – we have 38 paid members and \$4110.96 in the checking account and \$36.10 in the Flower Fund.

Old Business:

Springtime in the Smokies: We have received our portion of the proceeds from the show in the amount of \$1900. Blount British Cars received the same amount and a small portion was set aside to cover next year's show. This means we raised in excess of \$3800 of which \$1900 came from the silent auction.

Discussion was had regarding how to split the money between our designated charities as we have a bank balance of \$4100 and few actual club expenses and after much discussion the club voted as follows:
